National Baked Goods Company Reduces Chargebacks by 87% and streamlines distribution network

OVERVIEW

A manufacturer of baking goods, breakfast foods, and desserts was seeking a third-party logistics provider (3PL) to design and deliver an optimized supply chain that would control distribution costs and improve retail compliance processes with major retail partners like Walmart, Target, Kroger, Albertsons, and other major food retailers.



The company was looking to unify multiple brands under a single supply chain solution that would improve operational efficiencies.

- Inefficient retail compliance processes were straining relations with Walmart, Target and major food distributors.
